Verizon now launches its standard 5G UWB (Ultra Wideband) mobility price plans with accessibility to all 5G spectrums.

The 5G UWB plans offers access to all 5G spectrums (C-band, mm-Wave with 4G LTE fallback) with no throttling or deprioritization and is offered in three different options based on your consumption needs. These cost effective plans offer data sharing across multiple lines and do not require location validation.

Plan Details

Plan Details: These are Verizon's first standard 5G Ultra Wideband plans for our Machine to Machine customers and are available in three options with different allowances (50GB, 100Gb & 200GB). Coverage includes Verizon Wireless Triband with 5G Ultra Wideband network (C-band and mm-Wave), 5G Nationwide® network, and 4G network.

The plans are available at QCI 8 with no throttling or deprioritization.

Devices: All 5G data devices certified on the VZ network, including certified customer-provided devices (BAU on certification process if not already certified on VZ network).

Accessibility: Plans are available for the customers through multiple front-end portals like MyBiz, B360 & ThingSpace.

Data Sharing: Data allowance is inclusive of 5G and 4G domestic data usage. Sharing among M2M Lines is available only among M2M Lines active on these plans. At the end of each billing cycle, any unused data allowances for lines sharing on the same account will be applied to the overages of the other lines on the same account beginning with the line with the lowest overage need.

Video Shaping: Video applications will stream at up to 720p while on 4G and 5G Nationwide network areas; and, will apply video streaming up to 4K when on 5G UWB network service areas.

SMS: Unlimited messaging where messaging services are available.

Roaming: Equipment must be activated within the areas served by the Verizon Wireless owned and operated network in the United States and fixed-location Equipment must be deployed within these areas. Mobile Equipment may be used to roam on the networks of Verizon Wireless's roaming partners in the United States and incidentally in Canada and Mexico, but must be primarily used on Verizon Wireless's owned and operated networks in the United States. Equipment cannot be permanently located in a roaming area. Verizon Wireless reserves the right to terminate any M2M Lines that are not primarily used on Verizon Wireless's owned and operated network or are "Permanently Located" in Canada or Mexico.

The monthly access fee will be pro-rated when changing price plans during a billing cycle.

Subscribers on this plan cannot place or receive voice calls other than to 611 or 911 (these calls may be placed anywhere in the domestic Verizon Wireless coverage area).
